## 1. Step: Export Your Project From ATLAS.ti For Windows

- Update your windows version to version 7.5.x. Older windows versions do not include the export option for Mac.
- Open your project in ATLAS.ti for Windows 7.5.x.
- Select **PROJECT / EXPORT / MAC TRANSFER BUNDLE**.

## 2. Step: Importing Your Project In ATLAS.ti For Mac

- On your Mac, double-click on the exported file, or open ATLAS.ti for Mac first and select **PROJECT / OPEN** and then the import option.
